- **OMAA Committee** requested Honor Council representation for their training process. They are set to discuss Charlie and Muppets. Julien and Jacob will meet with them on Wednesday night at 10pm to work out the details and on Thursday for the actual training.
- **Faculty Outreach** started planning the faculty panel. Council discussed potential faculty members for the panel. Some names suggested were: Benston, Greene, Hohenstein, Gould, Mortimer, Partridge, Newirth.
- **Community Outreach** will hold a mock trial for the community on Wednesday, April 13. Time and location are still in the works.
- **Diversity Training** is in the works for the current Honor Council. Members brought up the following suggestions for diversity trainings.
  - Stephanie feels the training is important because it provide Council with perspective on diversity issues such as the fine line between free speech and racism. We should understand these concerns and hear from community members that have been discriminated against.
  - We need to address class issues because separation directly relates to somebody's economic class.
  - Someone suggested that the new OMAAs should train Honor Council.
- **Minutes** are in for an overhaul. How should we post them? Should we continue to post them?
  - Council reaffirmed its commitment to posting in dormitories. Council will redistribute the responsibilities for Council members who are assigned to academic buildings.
- **The Librarian** position is being further developed by Council. Council acknowledges it needs more meetings to address this issue. Some questions raised were:
  - How much access to confidential information should this student have?
  - Should they have input in the trial process?
  - Council concluded that this position might change how Council works.
- **Bryn Mawr** selected new Honor Board student leaders. Oleg will contact her for a meeting.
- **Honor Code T-Shirts** were considered as a fundraising device for a new customs week tradition. Council would like to see shirts but will be happy to have Customs Committee create the design for the new program.
